**TTNA Training - 2007**

With cooperation and funding from the International Fibre Centre under its Training and Education Projects (TEP) program, and in collaboration with CSIRO Textile and Fibre Technology, the TTNA is able to develop and deliver the following two courses in 2007:

- The Mechanics of Adhesion and the Coatings & Laminates Program  
This four day training consists of one day (optional) at CSIRO TFT in Belmont on The Mechanics of Adhesion, followed by three days at RMIT University in Brunswick covering the Coatings and Laminates Program.
- Carding: Theory and Practice in the Work Place  
This training will take place in the participating companies' respective work places, especially tailored to each company's products and problems and including practical demonstrations of theory on their own equipment. Systematic problem solving techniques will be included.
